Key services and programs

Orthopedics & Sports Medicine – This program offers specialty care to patients suffering from injuries and diseases affecting bones, joints, ligaments, tendons, muscles, nerves. Methodist Hospital is proud to be designated a Blue Distinction Center for Knee and Hip Replacement and included on Becker's Hospital Review's list of "60 Hospitals with Great Orthopedic Programs." Methodist also offers the MAKO robotic surgical system – the first such system in the Sacramento area to offer surgeons 3D pre-surgical planning and real-time visual, tactile and auditory feedback.

Rehab Center – Our full-service center is one of only two facilities in Sacramento that features an indoor, heated, therapeutic swimming pool and health and wellness programs. Services also include a full range of programs geared toward rehabilitating athletes and injured workers.

Hand Therapy Program – This program offers patients a comprehensive approach to hand, wrist and elbow injuries caused by carpal tunnel syndrome, rheumatoid arthritis or sports or work-related injuries. Patients work directly with a Certified Hand Therapist at Methodist's Outpatient Rehab Center.

Family Birth Center – Each Family Birth Center suite has state-of-the art equipment, with labor, delivery and recovery taking place in the comfort of our spacious, private rooms. The center also includes a level II Neonatal Intensive Care Unit for premature and seriously ill infants.

Bariatric Program – We offer a multi-disciplinary, team-centered approach and have been recognized as a Bariatric Surgery Center of Excellence by the American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery. The program offers patients three types of weight loss surgery: gastric bypass, lap band and sleeve gastrectomy.

Bruceville Terrace – Licensed to Methodist Hospital, this 171-bed sub-acute skilled nursing long-term care facility provides care for the elderly, as well as those requiring extended recoveries.

Mercy Family Residency Program – Established in 1995, this accredited and nationally recognized three-year program of excellence provides resident physicians with specialty training in primary care family practice.

Expanding to meet your needs

Expanded Emergency Room (ER) – Methodist’s ER includes more than 21,000 square feet, 29 patient rooms, most of which are completely private rooms and three that are critical resuscitation rooms built for rapid response to any medical emergency. The project sets a new standard for healthcare excellence in the southern Sacramento County, while maintaining our heritage of caring for every person. The ER can serve more than 75,000 patients a year, is equipped with electronic medical records and is connected to the county-wide Emergency Management System.

New Operating Room (OR) – A high-tech operating room opened in 2007 for minimally-invasive surgery, called laparoscopic surgery, in areas of general and orthopedic surgery, gastric bypass and plastic & reconstructive surgery. The OR incorporates Internet technology for communication with surgeons for teaching purposes throughout the U.S. and the world.
